Peg Dittmar is known as the “Painter of Birds.” Her fondness of the avian variety began in Key West where the birds would arrive at the docks in search of food. They would get close enough for photographs that captured every detail. She has painted birds of all varieties including swans, snowy egrets and great blue herons. Many of the birds that Dittmar paints are found locally in her home of Cape May Courthouse, NJ.

Dittmar is a very accomplished painter. She has been showing her paintings in many juried as well as invitational shows, such as Immaculata University for seven years. She has received prizes such as First Prize at the National Arts Program, Best of Show and People’s Choice Award at various competition.

Dittmar also was accepted in the John J. Audubon Juried show where she won not one but two Best of Shows and First Prize in consecutive shows. On top of all that, she has also participated in the prestigious Barnabas Art Group for the past 25 years.

Peg Dittmar has built herself quite the art resume working with such places like the Cape May County Art League, Ocean City Fine Arts and the Noyes Museum of Art of Stockton University. She has been an Artist Member with the Noyes Museum of Art of Stockton University for many years and has exhibited her work many times across several locations.
