- Founded in 1983, The Noyes Museum of Art's permanent collections, educational programs, and changing exhibitions serve as a local and national resource for schools, colleges, social and civic organizations and for individuals who are interested in expanding their understanding, appreciation, and knowledge of American culture through its fine and folk arts and crafts.

- With locations in Atlantic City, Galloway Township & Hammonton, the museum's galleries are also conveniently accessible to audiences in New York, Philadelphia and Baltimore.
- The Noyes Museum formally became a part of Stockton University in 2016. Home to one of the area's top performing arts centers, Stockton has its own art gallery, a growing visual arts program, and a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree has been added to the courses of study.

Volunteers are expected to be able to be on your feet for long periods of time, lift objects of varying weight, and take direction from staff.

Grounds Special Projects: Assist in the outside appearance of the Arts Garage. We are searching for volunteers with landscaping and gardening experience to assist in keeping our grounds colorful, clean, and welcoming to the public.

Special Events: Assist with various aspects of event preparation, such as set-up, clean-up, refreshments, and more. Events include Second Fridays, concerts, poetry readings and other enriching programs & events. Volunteers are expected to have a flexible schedule to meet the needs of events. Experience with children is preferred, but not necessary.
